### 2010-2011 School Calendar

The 2010-2011 School Year runs Aug. 18 through June 9. There will be no classes offered in July 2011. Classes will resume on or about August 18, 2011.

This school tuition is paid monthly over 11 monthly through July 31, 2011. The first and last months of attendance at Catalyst are prorated.

Regular tuition payments apply monthly from August through July, regardless of the number of classes on a student's schedule or the number of days of school in the month. The same tuition applies also regardless of a family's vacation plans.

### Tuition Payments

Monthly Tuition Payments must be received before the last day of the prior month by 4:00 PM. (Example: The November Tuition Payment must be received by Catalyst no later than 4:00 PM on October 31.) A Late Payment Fee of \$25 per day will accrue for any payment received after the day it is due. To avoid late a late payment, automatic payments are preferred and recommended.

To resume classes in fall 2011, all tuition and fees from the 2010-2011 School Year must be paid, and the full month tuition for August, at the 2011-2012 Tuition Rate, must be paid. A student may not be withdrawn or payments suspended, during a holiday or vacation period, and then reenrolled without making up unpaid tuition.

Thirty days notice is required for withdrawal of a student. Failure to provide 30 days notice will result in forfeiture of all tuition, fees, and deposits paid. All tuition payments, invoices, deposits, and reparations due to Catalyst High School must be paid before a student's official school-related information, including transcripts, will be released to a student, a student's family, another school or other third party.
